All members have full voting privileges.

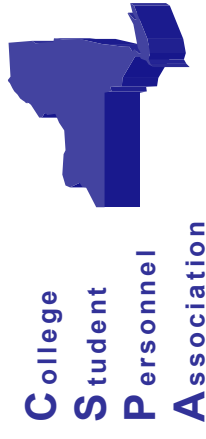
